Dear Parent/Guardian,

As part of their GCSE studies in English Literature, Year 11 have been invited to take part in a visit to an evening performance of An Inspector Calls on **Thursday 14th November 2019** at the Birmingham Repertory Theatre in Birmingham. This trip is a fantastic opportunity for our students to see a live performance of one of their set texts, and will provide them with a valuable understanding of the play.

Students should meet at school at 6.00pm and the coach will **leave school at 6.15pm prompt** as the performance begins at 7.30pm. The running time for the performance is not yet confirmed but is expected to be around two and a half hours, so we hope to **return to school by approximately 11.00pm**. Students will text/telephone from the coach to confirm this so please ensure that you are contactable, the school mobile phone will be available. **Please note we do not allow students to walk home alone at night. The cost of the trip is £29.00 to cover admission, transport and insurance.**

Students will have time at the theatre to purchase food and drink for the performance, but are welcome to bring their own packed lunches from home. No refreshments will be provided by school.

If you would like your son/daughter to take part, please ensure you complete a new online medical form in **September** via your Mychild account for the academic year 2019/20 as **we cannot accept your son/daughter onto the trip without one**. You can now pay online, using your Parent Pay log in details.

The payment deadline for this trip is **Friday 22nd March 2018**. To avoid disappointment, please pay at your earliest convenience as tickets are limited. If the trip is oversubscribed then names will be drawn at random and refunds issued to those not gaining a place. These students will then be placed on a reserve list.

At Polesworth we do our best to show consideration for our neighbours. In order to help us to do this we request that parents use the school car park to deliver and collect students. Students waiting to leave should remain on the school car park.

All fees for this activity are paid on a voluntary basis. If sufficient money is not raised to cover the costs of the activity, then the activity may be cancelled. If you have any queries regarding this, please do not hesitate to contact me.
