Ways to learn and retrieve knowledge!

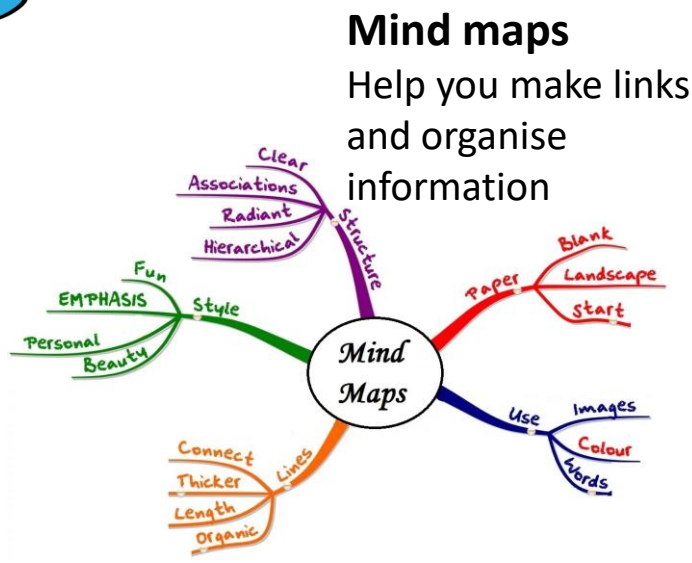
Read Aloud
Simply speak the facts and dates out loud.



Post its
Using a pack of post-it notes, write out as many of the keywords or dates as you can remember in only 1 minute!

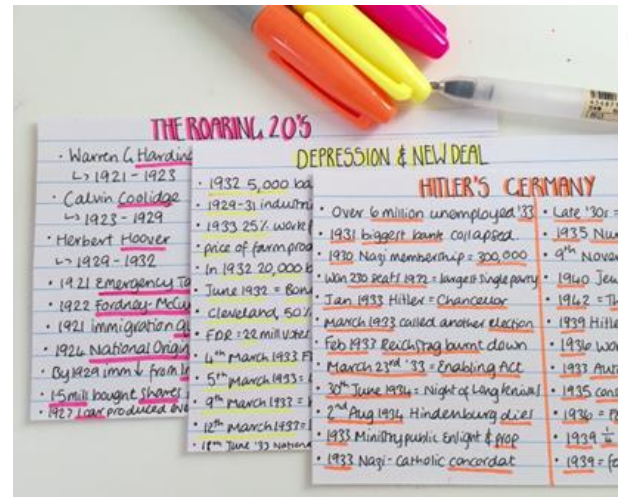


Teach it!
Teach someone the key facts and get them to test you!



Online learning
Find videos, step-by-step guides, activities and quizzes by level and subject

Look, Cover, Write, Check
Look through your notes. Cover them up. Write down as much as you can remember. Check against the original. Highlight anything you got wrong or forgot. Prioritise these areas



Flashcards
Use both sides. One for key facts and one for the explanation.

List making
Make lists of key facts. Ask someone to test your recall.

Record it
Record yourself on your phone reading out the information. Recordings can be listened to as many times as you want.
