What curriculum topics are being covered this year?	Travel & Tourism organisations and destinations. Customer service in the industry. Influences on Global Travel & Tourism.
How many exams have students got and what is covered in each one?	<p>There is one exam in May of Year 11. This builds on the coursework knowledge gained in Travel & Tourism organisations and destinations and customer service in the industry. The exam focuses on the influences on global Travel & Tourism. The exam is two hours long and is worth 40% of the course</p> <p>Content of the exam. Factors influencing global travel and tourism. This includes the following:- Economic factors, recession/boom, employment, inflation, exchange rates. Political factors, legislation, passport/visa, civil unrest, political instability. Natural factors, disasters, weather, travel disruption, infrastructure. Media factors, types of print, images, coverage & choice. Safety, security, risks and decision making. Health risks and factors, endemic/pandemic/epidemic, diseases in the world. Responses to factors by government, businesses and voluntary sector businesses. Impact and management of travel and tourism and sustainability, sociocultural impacts, economic and environmental. Destination management, TALC model, tourism development, mature and developing destinations. The role of local and national governments. Role of partnerships in destination management.</p>
What should students be focusing on?	Knowledge and usage of key terms is the bare essential. Ability to understand context of scenarios and make realistic justifications. Analysing and evaluating figures and data relating to the industry and drawing realistic conclusions.
