What is the best way for parents to support students in this subject?	 Vocabulary practice – little and often. Encourage them to use their language skills at home. Encourage them to practise their paragraphs and other speaking activities aloud! Reinforce the value of languages in our modern globalised world.
What websites and resources would be helpful? What wider reading would be helpful? Where can I get resources?	 GCSE Bitesize. Kerboodle – log-in issued by class teacher. Quizlet/Mem-rise. CGP revision booklet / practice book. Weekly Homework and Revision booklets Teachit revision booklet (issued by teacher in lessons). Purple speaking booklet – with model answers and phrases to support home learning. Vocabulary packs and Knowledge organisers.
Have previous students got any tips or advice for this subject?	 Revise little and often (10 – 15 minutes daily). Practise aloud any aspect of the speaking. Practise vocabulary every day. Attend weekly 30 minute revision sessions regularly.
