Which exam board and course are used?	AQA
What curriculum topics are being covered this year?	Coasts, fieldwork including a trip to Carding Mill Valley, Resources in the UK, Global Water Resources, Tectonics, Tropical Storms, pre-release Issue evaluation booklet, and then revision.
How many exams have students got and what is covered in each one?	<p>Students will have one formal assessment at the end of each topic. Additionally, practice past-paper questions will be embedded throughout each topic to be completed either during lessons or as homework activities. Prior to Christmas they will have two mock exams – a Paper 1 and then another that will include a combination of questions from papers 2 and 3. There will be a further mock in March which will include content the cohort struggled with in the earlier mocks.</p> <p>GCSE Paper 1: Physical Geography: Ecosystems & Tropical Rainforests, Hot Deserts, Coasts, Rivers, Diverse Landscapes, Climate Change, Tectonics, Tropical Storms & UK Weather Hazards.</p> <p>GCSE Paper 2: Human Geography: Resources in the UK, Global Water Issues, Development (inc. Nigeria), UK Urban Change, Urbanisation [Mumbai] & UK Economic Futures.</p> <p>GCSE Paper 3: Issue Evaluation (based on pre-release) & Unseen Fieldwork/Geographical Skills.</p>
What should students be focusing on?	<p>Students should be focusing on learning the key content and practicing their geographical skills such as describing, explaining, assessing, evaluating and map-skills.</p> <p>Specific case-study content is crucial to success. This should be revised periodically.</p>
What is the best way for parents to support students in this subject?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talk and ask them what they have been learning about. • Encourage them to watch any geographical documentaries. • Watch the news or follow a news App. • Encourage them to revise key geographical terminology, and for assessments • Remind them there is a 'Geography Revision' group on Microsoft Teams they are a member of and that they can use it to ask us questions, engage with lesson content and past paper questions, as well as revision strategies.

This is a fantastic website which allows students to revise their understanding of physical and human processes. https://timeforgeography.co.uk/# . • The BBC bitesize Geography website is also really good and specific to the AQA course https://www.bbc.com/education/examspecs/zy3ptyc • Seneca. Useful for revision and testing subject knowledge. • Buy a GCSE revision guide – the CGP ones are fantastic (make sure you get the AQA one) – these are available at WH Smiths, Waterstones, Amazon etc. • Students will be given access to a knowledge organiser that contains a summary of the course which can be used for revising. • Their revision group on Microsoft Teams.
