What should students be focusing on?	<ul> <li>Building up vocabulary over time – the little and often approach.</li> <li>Structure to transfer from topic to topic.</li> <li>Developing answers – to give extended answers with reasons, opinions.</li> <li>Revise / develop confidence with tenses and using 3 tenses confidently.</li> <li>Reading aloud – practising key sounds.</li> </ul>
What is the best way for parents to support students in this subject?	<ul> <li>Vocabulary practice – little and often (4 – 5 times a week for 20 -30 minutes).</li> <li>Encourage them to use their language skills at home.</li> <li>Encourage them to practise their paragraphs and other speaking or read aloud activities!</li> <li>Reinforce the value of languages in our modern globalised world.</li> <li>Use Activehub (all students will have a login) to practice vocabulary and listening activities at home.</li> </ul>

Where can I get resources?	<ul> <li>GCSE Bitesize.</li> <li>Activehub – online learning platform – log-in issued by class teacher.</li> <li>Quizlet/Mem-rise/ Duolingo.</li> <li>Pearson revision booklet / practice book.</li> <li>Weekly Homework and Revision booklets.</li> <li>Department Revision booklet (issued by teacher in lessons).</li> <li>GCSE speaking booklet – with model answers and phrases to support home learning.</li> </ul>

	Vocabulary packs and Knowledge organisers – issued by the class teacher each term to be revised in and out of lesson.
Have previous students got any tips or advice for this subject?	<ul> <li>Revise little and often – vocabulary, reading aloud, reading, listening, speaking &amp; writing (10 – 15 minutes daily).</li> <li>Practise aloud any aspect of the speaking.</li> <li>Practise vocabulary every day – using your knowledge organiser / vocabulary booklet / Duolingo.</li> <li>Attend weekly 30-minute revision sessions.</li> <li>Listen to as much of the target language out of lessons as possible (radio, podcasts, TV programmes, music, etc).</li> </ul>
