What should students be focusing on?	Students have homework set on Dr Frost weekly. Full completion of the homework is essential as research has shown this has a great impact on their overall grade. Homework will focus on exam practice each week. Students can also use Dr Frost to complete independent revision. Once their assessments have been completed a grid highlighting their personal strengths and weaknesses will be shared with students and parents.
