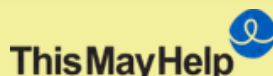
Thank you for your continued support and for contributing to another fantastic year at our school.

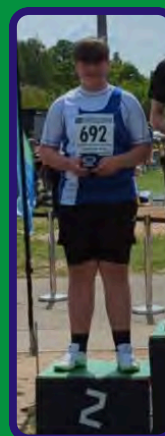
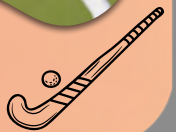
Celebrating our amazing students and their incredible achievements both in and out of the classroom.

We'd especially like to thank our amazing Science Department for their constant support, encouragement and belief in our students' potential that made this achievement possible.

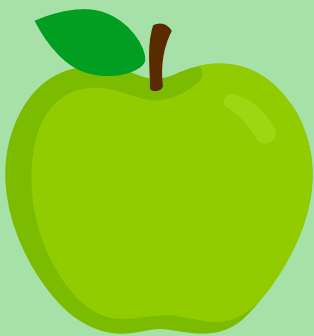
TEEN TECH AWARDS 2026

CELEBRATING 70 YEARS OF THE GOLD DUKE OF EDINBURGH AWARD



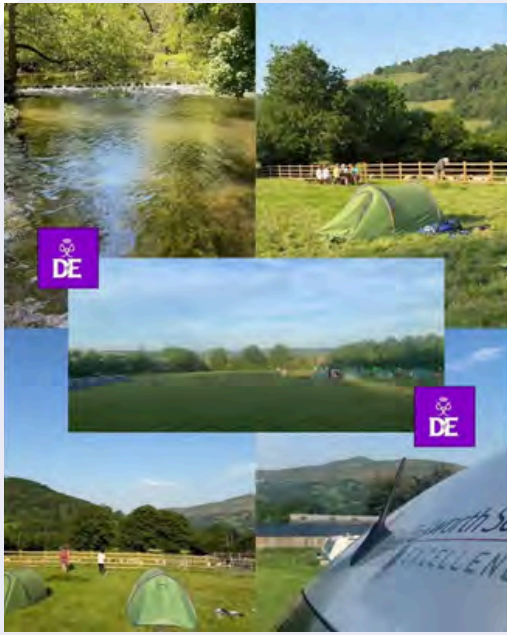

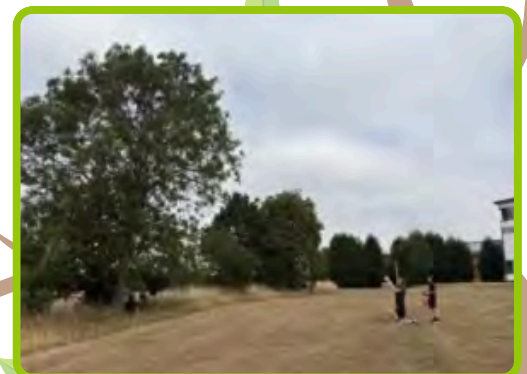
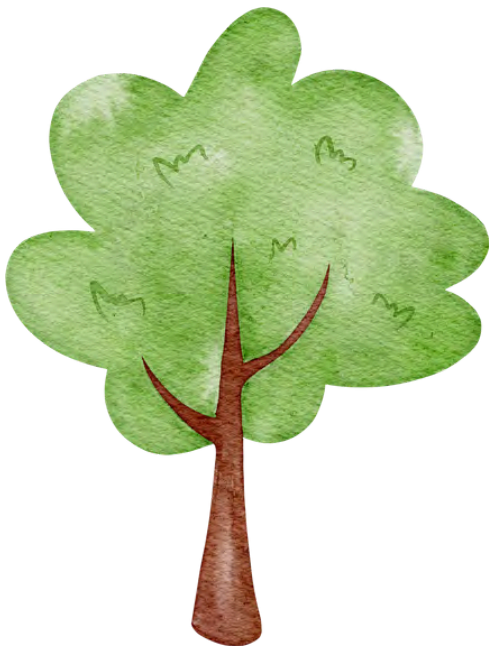


Geography
